

2026 Rehost Digital Impact Grant

Turn an app, portal, website, or business tool into something people can use. If approved, the first version may be covered and monthly costs reduced after launch.

Why Is This Available?

Rehost received a mix of public and private grant funding to help eligible businesses, local governments, and community organizations build and replace useful software. Approved projects may have their initial development costs covered and ongoing costs reduced.

Who It Is For:

- Small and medium-sized businesses or LLCs that mainly serve clients in the United States.
- Cities, municipalities, and local government agencies.
- Local nonprofits, community organizations, and other public-serving organizations.
- Each project must help a business attract or serve customers, or provide a clear local benefit.

What You Get:

- **A dedicated team:** A product manager and vetted developers plan, build, and launch your project.
- **A covered first version:** If approved, the initial build and launch would be completely covered.
- **Ongoing support:** Hosting, maintenance, updates, and continued development after launch.
- **Direct access:** Call or text your team when you need help.
- **Clear terms:** Plans usually run \$850 to \$4,500 per month. Ownership and renewal terms are confirmed in writing, with no equity or long-term lock-in.

What Could You Build?

Audience	Examples	Benefit
Businesses	Loyalty apps; tenant or customer portals; search-friendly pages; booking, ordering, or CRM systems	Attract customers, replace subscriptions, and reduce manual work
Cities and local governments	Resident portals; request tracking; resource directories; public dashboards	Make local services easier to access
Community organizations	Member or volunteer portals; training hubs; enrollment or donor systems	Serve participants and manage programs in one place
Modernize what you already have: Approved projects can update or replace websites, apps, portals, databases, and internal tools.		

How It Works:

1. Tell us what you need, who it serves, and what it could replace.
2. Rehost checks the fit and submits the formal inquiry. You do not apply directly.
3. If approved, the scope, costs, ownership, and launch target are confirmed in writing before work begins.
